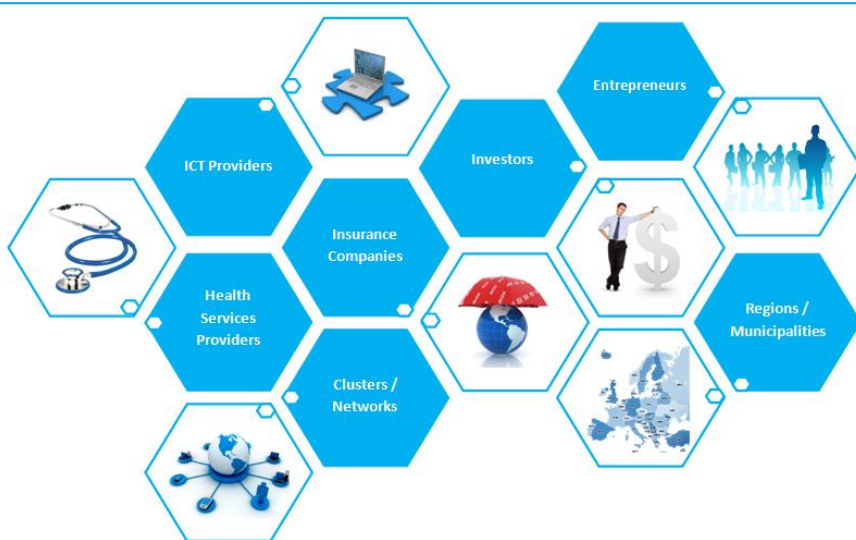

2nd AgeingWell National Event – Rome, Italy

Technopolo, S.p.A. held the 2nd **AgeingWell** National Event on the 7th June 2012 in parallel to the "Capitale Conoscenza" conference, at La Pelanda MACRO Testaccio, Rome.

The annual conference of the Ambient Assisted Living Joint Programme, the AAL Forum, took place between 24th and 27th September 2012. The main themes of the 2012 Forum were: EU and National policies; AAL projects: outcomes and future; From research to innovation: delivering innovations; and Cutting edge ideas.

The 1st **International Event of the AgeingWell** was held within the AAL Venture Days promoted under the AAL Forum, gathering, among others, investors, funders and high tech, high-growth companies. One of the main focus was on Healthy Ageing, specially on innovative technologies that improve the (quality of) life of elderly people. AAL Event at the EU parliament | 2014-2020 - Managing an aged society while promoting sustainable and smart businesses: The future strategy of the AAL Joint Programme

The conference aims to present the future strategy of the programme (that is dedicated to address the issue of ageing in Europe through the use of ICT) in the view of the eventual follow up for the period between 2014-2020.

MEP Heinz Becker and MEP Lambert Van Nistelroy will co-host the conference on **October 16th from 3:00 to 6:00 PM**, in Brussels, with two main objectives:

- to share the outcomes of the AAL JP following five years of stimulating innovation in the field of ICT for ageing, resulting in SMEs and other organizations building new supply chains and collaborations;
- to illustrate the advantages of a follow-up Joint Programme across Europe for the period 2014-2020 and explore how to stimulate economic growth whilst improving the quality of life of EU citizens.
